An application for financial assistance that is submitted by a housing development to the department before September 1, 2013, is governed by the law in effect when the application was submitted, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. [FA1(5)] SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies SECTION 3. [Deleted by FA1(4)] Same as Senate version. only to an application for financial assistance that is submitted to the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs during an application cycle that begins on or after the effective date of this Act.
