IN RE: HB1534 by Leach (Relating to the designation of certain segments of highway in Collin County and Jim Wells County.), Conference Committee Report

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would require the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) to design, construct, and erect highway markers designating a segment of U.S. Highway 75 as the Sam Johnson Highway, subject to Section 225.021 (c), Transportation Code.

The bill would require TxDOT to design, construct, and erect highway markers designating a segment of U.S. Highway 281 as the Lt. General Marc Cisneros Highway, subject to Section 225.021 (c), Transportation Code.

Section 225.021 (c), Transportation Code, specifies that TxDOT is not required to design, construct, or erect the marker unless a grant or donation of funds is made to the department to cover the cost. Based on the information provided by TxDOT, it is assumed any duties associated with the implementation of the provisions of the bill could be absorbed within the agency's existing resources.
