BACKGROUND

DIGEST:

HB 2280 would allow persons to be hold the office of municipal court judge for more than one municipality if they were appointed to each post. The bill also would declare that the holding of such offices would be of benefit to the state.

HB 2280 would take immediate effect if finally passed by a two-thirds record vote of the membership of each house.
