DIGEST: SB 1837 would authorize the Office of the Secretary of State to increase

certain fees it charges for expedited filing and handling of business

documents. It would increase:

• from \$5 to \$25 the fee assessed for expedited handling of a certified record search or document filing in its records of security interest and financing statements;

- from \$10 to \$50 the fee charged for expedited filing or reviewing of a document relating to a profit or nonprofit corporation, professional corporation or association, cooperative association, limited or general partnership, or limited liability association, and include unincorporated nonprofit associations within this group; and
- from \$5 to \$10 the fee for expedited handling of a request for a certified copy or certificate of fact relating to a corporation, limited partnership,

assumed name, trademark document, or other document filed for public record with the corporations section of the office.

SB 1837 would take effect September 1, 1997.

NOTES: A related bill, SB 1838 by Ratliff, increasing other fees collected by the secretary of state, passed the House on May 25.
