**BACKGROUND:** Education Code, sec. 130.191 specifies that the North Harris Montgomery

Community College District includes 13 school districts in Harris County and

two districts in Walker County.

DIGEST: HB 1316 would add the territory within the Cypress-Fairbanks Independent

School District to the service area of the North Harris Montgomery

Community College District.

This bill would take immediate effect if finally passed by a two-thirds record

vote of the membership of each house. Otherwise, it would take effect

September 1, 2003.

**SUPPORTERS** 

SAY:

HB 1316 would codify in statute the inclusion of Cypress-Fairbanks ISD in the North Harris Montgomery County Community College District, a decision

that was approved by local voters in August, 2000. Cypress-Fairbanks

currently is not assigned to any community college service area, but residents have paid in-district tuition since the August referendum. HB 1316 would make it clear in statute that these students are entitled to in-district tuition.
