BACKGROUND: Human Resources Code, ch. 42, regulates certain homes, facilities and

agencies, including foster homes, agency foster homes, and child-placing

agencies.

DIGEST: CSHB 3137 would amend Human Resources Code, ch. 42 by adding sec.

42.0452 to require the Department of Family and Protective Services (DFPS) to develop a statement listing the rights and responsibilities of a foster parent or an agency foster home and of the department or a child-

placing agency.

DFPS would have to provide a written copy of the statement to each foster parent in a foster home and to each child-placing agency licensed by the department. A child-placing agency would provide a written copy of the

statement to each foster parent in an agency foster home.

The bill would take immediate effect if finally passed by a two-thirds record vote of the membership of each house. Otherwise, it would take

effect September 1, 2009.
