BACKGROUND: Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes art. 5190.14 sec. 5A specifies the events

that are eligible for reimbursement under the Major Events

Reimbursement Program. These events include the Super Bowl, an NCAA Final Four tournament game, a World Cup soccer game, the Breeders' Cup World Championships, among others as specified in

statute.

DIGEST: CSHB 2402 would make a championship event in the National Reined

Cow Horse Association and a CONVRG conference eligible for funding

under the Major Events Reimbursement Program.

The bill would take immediate effect if finally passed by a two-thirds record vote of the membership of each house. Otherwise, it would take

effect September 1, 2019.
