BACKGROUND: Education Code sec. 11.1513 requires the board of trustees of each
independent school district to adopt a policy providing for the
employment and duties of district personnel.

DIGEST: HB 3323 would require any school district that has a website to post its
employment policy and the full text of any regulations or forms referenced
in the policy on its website.

The bill would take effect September 1, 2019.
