public school students, TxDMV would be required to issue specialty license plates that included the words "Retired Texas Teacher" and depicted a Texas public education logo. The issuance fee for the license plates for retired classroom teachers would be \$5, and a person would be issued one set of plates without being required to pay a vehicle registration fee.

The bill would take effect September 1, 2019.
