BACKGROUND: Concerns have been raised that current statute does not provide adequate

flexibility to set salaries in cases in which qualified employees transfer to

a new position within the same agency and in the same salary group.

DIGEST: HB 2743 would allow a state employee's salary rate to be set at any rate in

the appropriate salary group if the employee:

• transferred within a state agency between two classified positions that were allocated to the same salary group and had the same title as listed in the general appropriations act;

- transferred to a position for which the employment opening was publicly listed with the Texas Workforce Commission;
- voluntarily applied for the position to which the employee transferred; and
- agreed to accept the position to which the employee transferred at the publicly listed salary.

The bill would take effect September 1, 2021, and would apply only to a

transfer of position that took effect on or after that date.
