DIGEST

Currently, the name of a person holding a wine and beer retailer's permit or retail dealer's on-premise license is required to be printed on the face of retail alcoholic beverage certificates. If the owner is not a person, then the name of the person or entity responsible for the management of the premises must be printed on the face of retail alcoholic beverage certificates. This bill sets forth provisions regarding the contents of certain retail alcoholic beverage permits and licences.

PURPOSE

As proposed, H.B. 2584 sets forth provisions regarding certain retail alcoholic beverage permits and licenses.

RULEMAKING AUTHORITY

This bill does not grant any additional rulemaking authority to a state officer, institution, or agency.

SECTION BY SECTION ANALYSIS

SECTION 1. Repealers: Sections 25.08 and 69.08, Alcoholic Beverage Code (Contents of Permit and Contents of License).

SECTION 2. Effective date: September 1, 1997.

SECTION 3. Emergency clause.
