## **DIGEST AND PURPOSE**

Under current Texas law, it is illegal to bring prohibited weapons on to school premises. In this application the term "premises," currently defined as a building or portion of a building, does not include certain peripheral areas such as driveways, sidewalks, and parking areas. As proposed, S.B. 402 expands the definition of a premises to include public or private driveways, streets, sidewalks or walkways, or certain parking areas.

## **RULEMAKING AUTHORITY**

This bill does not expressly grant any additional rulemaking authority to a state officer, institution, or agency.

## **SECTION BY SECTION ANALYSIS**

SECTION 1. Amends Section 46.03(c), Penal Code, to redefine and define "premises" for two separate applications.

SECTION 2. Makes application of this Act prospective.

SECTION 3. Effective date: September 1, 2001.
