DIGEST AND PURPOSE

Currently, many single county groundwater districts in Texas are authorized to use the four county commissioner precincts and one at-large precinct for electing directors. H.B. 3229 allows the Blanco-Pedernales Groundwater Conservation District the option of using either the precinct method or the county commissioner precinct method in electing directors.

RULEMAKING AUTHORITY
