### **DIGEST AND PURPOSE**

Current law limits liability for municipal park systems that install skate parks. C.S.H.B. 3248 extends limits on liability to county and state skate parks.

### **RULEMAKING AUTHORITY**

This bill does not expressly grant any additional rulemaking authority to a state officer, institution, or agency.

### **SECTION BY SECTION ANALYSIS**

SECTION 1. Amends Sections 75.002(e), (f), and (g), Civil Practice and Remedies Code, as follows:

(e) Redefines “recreation” by adding “on premises,” rather than “inside a facility,” in relation to the location where certain recreational activities occur. Adds “the state” and “or county for the purposes of those activities” in reference to ownership, operation, or maintenance of such a facility.

(f) Makes conforming changes.

(g) Makes conforming changes. Requires a sign that contains specified warning language.

SECTION 2. Makes application of this Act prospective.

SECTION 3. Effective date: September 1, 2003.
