## **DIGEST AND PURPOSE**

Due to the continued growth and development of Comal County, there is a need for additional resources to sufficiently address a number of governmental issues. As proposed, S.B. 468 would create an additional county court at law for Comal County with the same jurisdiction as the current county court.

## **RULEMAKING AUTHORITY**

This bill does not expressly grant any additional rulemaking authority to a state officer, institution, or agency.

## **SECTION BY SECTION ANALYSIS**

SECTION 1. Amends Section 25.0481, Government Code, to provide that Comal County has two statutory county courts, County Court at Law No. 1 and County Court at Law No. 2 of Comal County.

SECTION 2. Provides that the County Court at Law No. 2 is created and this Act takes effect September 1, 2003.
