AUTHOR'S/SPONSOR'S STATEMENT OF INTENT

C.S.H.B. 540 names a portion of United States Highway 290 inside Harris County as the Ronald Reagan Memorial Highway.

RULEMAKING AUTHORITY

This bill does not expressly grant any additional rulemaking authority to a state officer, institution, or agency.

SECTION BY SECTION ANALYSIS

SECTION 1. Amends Subchapter B, Chapter 225, Transportation Code, by adding Section 225.059, as follows:

Sec. 225.059. RONALD REAGAN MEMORIAL HIGHWAY. (a) Designates the part of U.S. Highway 290 in Harris County between the Harris County boundary with Waller County and Beltway 8 as the Ronald Reagan Memorial Highway.

- (b) Requires the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) to design and construct memorial makers indicating the highway number, the designation as the Ronald Reagan Memorial Highway, and any other appropriate information.
- (c) Requires TxDOT to erect a marker at each end of the highway and at appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.
- (d) Provides that TxDOT is not required to design, construct, or erect a marker under this section unless TxDOT receives a grant or donation to cover the cost of the design, construction, and erection.
- (e) Requires funds collected under Section 225.021 (General Provisions) for the purposes of implementing this section to be deposited to the credit of the state highway fund.

SECTION 2. Effective date: September 1, 2005.
