### **AUTHOR'S / SPONSOR'S STATEMENT OF INTENT**

H.B. 1682 amends current law relating to prohibiting school districts from requiring or coercing school district employees to make charitable contributions.

### **RULEMAKING AUTHORITY**

This bill does not expressly grant any additional rulemaking authority to a state officer, institution, or agency.

### **SECTION BY SECTION ANALYSIS**

SECTION 1. Amends Subchapter A, Chapter 22, Education Code, by adding Section 22.011, as follows:

Sec. 22.011. REQUIRING OR COERCING EMPLOYEES TO MAKE CHARITABLE CONTRIBUTIONS. (a) Prohibits a school district board of trustees or school district employee from directly or indirectly requiring or coercing any school district employee to:

- (1) make a contribution to a charitable organization or in response to a fund-raiser; or
- (2) attend a meeting called for the purpose of soliciting charitable contributions.

(b) Prohibits a school district board of trustees or school district employee from directly or indirectly requiring or coercing any school district employee to refrain from:

- (1) making a contribution to a charitable organization or in response to a fund-raiser; or
- (2) attending a meeting called for the purpose of soliciting charitable contributions.

SECTION 2. Effective date: upon passage or September 1, 2011.
