AUTHOR'S / SPONSOR'S STATEMENT OF INTENT

H.B. 2771 amends current law relating to the purchasing powers and duties of a navigation district or port authority.

RULEMAKING AUTHORITY

This bill does not expressly grant any additional rulemaking authority to a state officer, institution, or agency.

SECTION BY SECTION ANALYSIS

SECTION 1. Reenacts Section 60.4305(a), Water Code, as amended by Chapter 415 (H.B. 1972) and 1191 (H.B. 3785), Acts of the 81st Legislature, Regular Session, 2009, and makes no further changes.

SECTION 2. Reenacts Sections 60.404(a) and (d), Water Code, as amended by Chapters 415 (H.B. 1972) and 1191 (H.B. 3785), Acts of the 81st Legislature, Regular Session, 2009, and makes no further changes.

SECTION 3. Reenacts Section 60.406(a), Water Code, as amended by Chapters 415 (H.B. 1972) and 1191 (H.B. 3785), Acts of the 81st Legislature, Regular Session, 2009, and makes no further changes.

SECTION 4. Provides that to the extent of any conflict, this Act prevails over another Act of the 82nd Legislature, Regular Session, 2011, relating to nonsubstantive additions to and corrections in enacted codes.

SECTION 5. Effective date: upon passage or September 1, 2011.
