## **AUTHOR'S / SPONSOR'S STATEMENT OF INTENT**

S.B. 78 adds Court Appointed Special Advocates (CASA) to the list of state entities eligible to receive used computers from the State of Texas. These computers will be available as a resource at CASA foster and group homes.

Access to computers for children involved with CASA:

- allows foster children to connect to all kinds of information and to become empowered and engaged;
- provides the opportunity for learning, bridging the digital divide, and giving children in foster care STEM learning opportunities through technology;
- helps foster children and youth stay on par with their classmates who have access to computers in their homes;
- and helps provide a sense of normalcy. (Original Author's / Sponsor's Statement of Intent)
- C.S.S.B. 78 amends current law relating to the disposition of state surplus or salvage data processing equipment by the Texas Department of Criminal Justice.

## **RULEMAKING AUTHORITY**

This bill does not expressly grant any additional rulemaking authority to a state officer, institution, or agency.

## **SECTION BY SECTION ANALYSIS**

SECTION 1. Amends Section 497.012(b), Government Code, as follows:

- (b) Requires the Texas Department of Criminal Justice (TDCJ) to sell the repaired or refurbished data processing equipment, in the following order of preference, to:
  - (1) a school district;
  - (2) a state agency;
  - (3) a political subdivision of the state; or
  - (4) a statewide organization described by Section 264.603(a) (relating to the Health and Human Services Commission contracting with a statewide organization that meets certain criteria to provide assistance to certain local volunteer advocate programs), Family Code, or a local volunteer advocate program, as defined by Section 264.601 (Definitions), Family Code, for use by children or youth in foster care.

Makes nonsubstantive changes.

SECTION 2. Effective date: September 1, 2017.
